Director of Public Works:

J. Frederick read his report. He also stated that he was informed about issues with the light poles at the park. Several light poles are rotten and pose an immediate risk to the public. He stated that J. Marques and himself are working on replacing the light poles.

J. Marques stated that there are 7 poles in total to replace, and he is estimating the cost to be around \$30,000. He stated that the park is now taped off for public safety and the poles will be replaced next week.

J. Frederick also stated that public works needs to purchase a plate compactor for cold patching. He says currently public works borrows a plate compactor from Biros and they do not want anything to happen to his compactor. He stated that he has looked around at prices and he believes the cost will be around \$2500. The board stated that this is a necessary piece of equipment and stated that it will be on the next agenda.

Chief of Police:

L. Pastick stated that he has had 13 traffic stops in the last 2 weeks. He stated that golf cart registrations are still coming in. D. Punke asked L. Pastick if he was going to start doing some afternoon hours. L. Pastick stated he may. D. Punke stated that she doesn't think its a you may, she added that she thinks you're going to have to. L. Pastick stated that he doesn't want to get into it. He added that that gets into a whole different thing, but he will be doing some hours. The village received \$174.50 from Grundy County. He also stated that he has had a couple residents question when the concrete work will be finished. J. Marques stated he will call Captains Concrete to find out when it will be finished. L. Pastick stated that his radar needs to be certified and he asked Braidwood Police Department to squeeze in with them on Wednesday when they get theirs certified.
